

MASC IN-PERSON PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

By participating in MASC programs, you agree to the following:

GUIDELINES

- The venue will ensure that all public health guidelines and protocols are being respected.
- All performances and workshops delivered in school or community settings, must take place in the presence of a person in a position of authority*.
- The venue will provide MASC with details such as contingency plans for weather conditions as well as relevant information regarding participants' mobility and cognitive abilities. Please notify MASC of any changes in location for the activities.
- Please be mindful of the planned start time and ensure that the audience is ready 10 minutes in advance of the activity.
- Please introduce the artist(s) prior to the performance; you may refer to the artists' bios which are available on the MASC website.
- Please inform front desk staff that this activity is taking place so that the artist is expected and welcomed.
- Photos and recordings of the activity are only allowed with permission from both the artist and the organizer.
- All content delivered in the workshops and performances is protected under Canada's Copyright Act. Reproduction of any material without prior permission from the artist(s) may fall into a violation of such law.
- Please refer to the Cancellation Policy for In-person programs if you need to cancel or reschedule the activity.

** Definition : A person in position of authority: a teacher, principal, parent, or organizer.*

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By participating in MASC programs, you agree to the following:

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Any communication between the artists and participating minors outside of MASC activity is not permitted unless supervised by a person in position of authority*.
- Respect the MASC artists, staff, and fellow participants at all times.
- Bullying, profanity, harassment, and discriminatory language or behaviour are strictly prohibited.
- If a participant does not respect the code of conduct, the person in position of authority* is required to take action, including removal from the event if necessary. If the situation persists, the artist has the right to cancel the event, at which point no refund will be provided.
